



2017 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS OVERVIEW

General Municipal Elections are held in odd numbered years. The elective officers of Midvale City consist of a city council made up of five council members representing districts 1-5 and a mayor, who are elected in a non-partisan election. The mayor and city council are elected to four-year overlapping terms.

Up for election this year 2017

District #4 – Council Member

District #5 – Council Member

Mayor – At Large

(All four year terms)

Citizens desiring to run for office must file a “***Declaration of Candidacy***” with the City Recorder between June 1, 2017 and June 7, 2017 at Midvale City Hall, 7505 South Holden Street, Midvale, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Interested candidates must be a registered voter, resident of Midvale City for at least 12 months immediately prior to the date of the election; and resident of the district candidate is running for 60 days prior to the date of the election.

2017 Election Dates & Information

Declaration of Candidacy Filing Dates: June 1-7, 2017 at 5:00 p.m.

Primary Election Day: August 15, 2017

General Election Day: November 7, 2017

Swearing-In Ceremony: January 1, 2018

Midvale City’s elections are “VOTE BY MAIL ONLY.” However, if you would like to vote on a voting machine, they will be available at Midvale City Hall from 7 am to 8 pm on election day.
